



## **Eddystone Youth Fund Application Process**

**(Formalized: 12/5/18)**

On November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2016 a Fund Agreement establishing the Eddystone Youth Fund under the auspices of The Community's Foundation (TCF) was formalized. *The Eddystone Youth Fund provides from the welfare of the youth of Eddystone through recreational, community, educational, and other beneficial programs and activities.* A group of Community Advisors provide advice to the TCF Board of Directors regarding the distribution of funds to *nonprofit and/or governmental organizations* that provide for the welfare of the youth of Eddystone.

### **Requirements for Funding:**

- Resources from the Eddystone Youth Fund can be distributed to support programs and projects of non-profits and/or governmental organizations.
- All requests for funding must pass through a formal, written process.
- The Eddystone Youth Fund requires that all programs/projects have diverse sources of funding. The Eddystone Youth Fund will not be the sole funder for any community projects. This rule encourages deep community buy-in and sustainability of programs.
- The Eddystone Youth Fund seeks to provide long-term support to the youth of Eddystone, and as such, will distribute resources in a manner that ensures fund longevity.

  - Project/Program Coordinator (Name, Title, Affiliation)
  - Project/Program Description
  - Amount Requested (\$)
  - Total Project/Program Budget (Itemized)
  - Other Sources of Funding
  - Timetable
  - Anticipated Impact (e.g. # participants)
  - Anticipated Outcome/Results
